Shenley Path opening

Hertfordshire County Council and Wrotham Park Settled Estates both received BHS Access Awards in Access Week for their role in opening a path.

Hertfordshire County Council cleared a very overgrown verge and culverted a ditch in a couple of places, to enable the path to be used year-round.

As there was not sufficient width in a verge for the route to go the whole length of the road, the County Council persuaded the next landowner along, Wrotham Park Settled Estates, to have a behind-the-hedge path to take riders, walkers and cyclists down to the next road junction.

In the Hertsmere District of Hertfordshire, the BHS committee has worked with the Patchetts Green Bridleways Trust to design seven new Ride-UK community circuits. This new verge route forms part of the Shenley Community Circuit.
