

## Project Brief LAF Schools and Rights Way

The Herts LAF has been allocated about £2500 to develop a project that would benefit the Hertfordshire community. A sub group is developing ideas about how children can be made aware of rights of way in their local areas especially around their school.

Thus the AIM is to engage with primary schools in a District of Hertfordshire by running a competition with prize money for the winning school. To make children and their parents aware of rights of way

We have had a range of ideas as to the best way of running this competition but feel we require the input of an expert educationalist in order to determine the appropriate level and how it could be best fitted into the already busy school curriculum / timetable.

Our ideas so far included:

- developing maps rights of way, taking photos, films, undertaking a survey of the condition of paths, signs, litter, safety etc – including issues about footpaths, dogs, litter, mud, horses, cattle
- developing learning welly walks – science / geography learning
- developing health walk routes for all ages (pram, old etc) – link to walk4life etc
- winning School also write piece about how they used money how enhanced learning
- a collect of different medium – evidence that they have been out there and thought about some of the issues
- possibly in the format of a Powerpoint ‘poster’
